- 1. Gentle Paws + Purring
 - Emotional bonding. Your cat feels safe and happy.
- 2. Intense Kneading with Claws
 - Possible anxiety or overstimulation. Check their stress levels.
- 3. Drooling During Kneading
 - Deeply rooted comfort behavior from kittenhood.
- 4. Kneading Only on You
 - You're their favorite. They're marking you with scent glands.
- 5. Kneading During Stress or Change
 - Self-soothing behavior. Try to reduce stressors at home.
- Quick Checklist What Is Your Cat Trying to Tell You?
- [] I'm relaxed and bonding
- [] I need comfort or reassurance
- [] This space/person is MINE
- [] I'm overstimulated, back off a bit
- [] I might be in heat or unspayed/neutered
- Vet-Backed Tips:
- Always watch body language (tail flicks, ears, eyes)
- Let your cat knead on a blanket if claws hurt
- If kneading increases suddenly, consult a vet
- Reinforce calm kneading with soft praise
- Bonus Tip:

Respond with calm touch, soft voice, or stillness.
