

Slime Removal From Carpet - Cheat Sheet

Step 1 - Freeze the slime with a sealed ice pack (10-15 min).

Step 2 - Gently scrape off hardened slime with a dull tool.

Step 3 - Spray vinegar + warm water (1:1) onto the residue. Let sit 3-5 min.

Step 4 - Blot (don't scrub!) with a clean white towel until the area is clear.

Step 5 - Sprinkle baking soda, spray with vinegar mix, let fizz, blot & vacuum.

Don't:

- Scrub or rub the slime (spreads deeper)
- Pour cleaning solution (can soak into carpet base)
- Use hot water (sets some dyes and glue)

Pro Mixes:

- Cleaning spray: 1 part vinegar + 1 part warm water + (optional) 2 drops dish soap
- Deep clean: Sprinkle baking soda -> spray vinegar mix -> let fizz -> blot -> vacuum

Carpet Tips:

- For shag carpets: Use vacuum hose for deep fiber extraction
- For delicate rugs: Always test cleaning mix on a hidden corner first
